Gateway is not an audit, and does not stop a project or programme.</p> <p>The OGC Gateway process:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> adds a second level of assurance</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> increases confidence in alignment of projects with Government strategic objectives</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> increases confidence in investment decisions</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> increases confidence in delivery of required project benefits to time and budget</li> </ul> <p>Gateway is applied in a number of international jurisdictions including the United Kingdom, the Netherlands and Australia. It was implemented in New Zealand in 2008 on the direction of Cabinet, and to date more than 150 reviews have been completed</p>
