Suitable: Level 3,4 – Guided / Independent / Shared

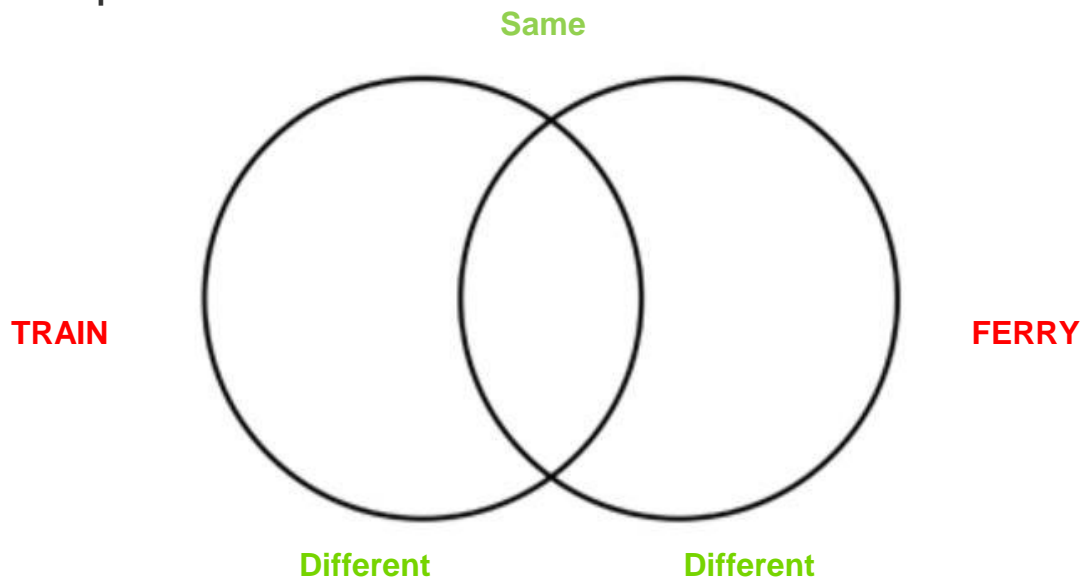
WALT: Compare and contrast two modes of transport.

A Venn Diagram is a tool designed to compare two things, two people, two events or two issues.

What to do?

In each circle you place a different topic. For each topic you write what is **different** about it compared to the other topic, and then in the middle, where the two circles overlap, you write what those two topics have in common. That is, what is similar (or the same).

Example





Train

Runs on tracks
Catch at a train station
Has a Train Driver

Similarities

Both are public transport
Both carry passengers
Both use HOP cards

Ferry

Runs on water
Catch at a wharf
Has a Captain
