Explanatory Note

This bylaw made pursuant to section 22AB of the Land Transport Act 1998, to amend clause 7(1) of the Auckland Transport Election Sign Bylaw 2013. This explanatory note is for information purposes only and does not form part of the bylaw.

1 Title

This bylaw is the Auckland Transport Election Signs Amendment Bylaw No 1 of 2013.

2 Commencement

The amendments made by this bylaw to the Auckland Transport Election Signs Bylaw 2013 come into force on 12 August 2013.

3 Amendment

- (1) New clauses or words are underlined while revoked clauses or words are struck through.
- (2) The following amendments are made to the explanatory note on the bylaw title page:

Explanatory Note

This bylaw made pursuant to section 22AB of the Land Transport Act 1998, allows ~~for~~ Auckland Transport to ~~make bylaws about~~ provide for the display of election signs that are on or visible from roads that are under the care, control or management of Auckland Transport. This bylaw revokes and replaces provisions of bylaws made by the previous local authorities of Auckland.

This explanatory note is for information purposes only and does not form part of this bylaw.

- (3) The following amendments are made to clause 7(1) of the Auckland Transport Election Signs Bylaw 2013:
 - (k) election signs, except for signs on commercial billboards, must not be internally illuminated by any means;
 - (l) election signs, except for signs on commercial billboards, must not be externally illuminated by any artificial lighting that is designed specifically to illuminate the election sign;
 - ~~(r) election sign lettering must not be less than~~
 - ~~(i) 120 mm in height on a road with a speed limit less than 70 km per hour;~~
 - ~~(ii) 160 mm in height on a road with a speed limit of 70 km or more; and~~
 - ~~(iii) the spacing between lines of text must not be less than 50 mm.~~
