New Retaining Wall on Caton Road – Update 3

Kia ora,

Here's our third update on how works are progressing on slip repairs on Caton Road.

What has been done so far?

The first of three stages of piling and anchoring is now complete, and we have started on the second stage. We are making good progress despite the challenging weather and have started working on Saturdays to increase weekly productivity.

What you'll see next week

- The team will be continuing the piling and soil anchoring works. Lifting operations will be underway during this phase and there will be heavy machinery along the side of the road.
- The road is narrower in the current stage, and we may need to hold traffic more often to allow the machines to move clear of the traffic lane. Traffic controllers will do their best to minimise any disruption.
- The second delivery of large materials is expected in the coming week which will require a temporary traffic stop. We will do our best to minimise any disruption.
- **We may need to hold traffic for up to 20 minutes during work hours (7am – 5pm). Please allow for extra time when travelling. We will update the white board at the entrance on Caton Rd to show when these deliveries are expected.**
