



**NOTES**

1. THERE ARE OTHER WAYS TO PROTECT FOOTPATHS DURING CONSTRUCTION APPROVAL TO USE THEM WILL REQUIRE COUNCIL APPROVAL.
2. UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL, PROVISION SHOULD BE MADE FOR CONTINUED USE OF FOOTPATH DURING CONSTRUCTION.
3. MINIMUM CONCRETE DEPTH OVER KERB AND BERM SHALL BE 150mm.
4. THIS PROTECTION SHALL COVER THE FULL WIDTH OF THE TEMPORARY ACCESS.
5. REFER CL. 3.10.3 OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE DESIGN STANDARDS MANUAL.
