What does this mean for East Auckland?

- 3 new frequent bus routes, all day, 7 days a week:
- every 10 minutes from Botany to the City Centre (70)
- every 15 minutes from Howick to Panmure (72C, 72M)
- every 15 minutes from Botany to Manukau (35)
- Travel towards the City Centre may involve a transfer to another bus or train.
- 3 Improved local buses to Half Moon Bay ferry
- New bus connections to local destinations:
- New services to connect Union Rd, Bradbury Rd,
 Cascades Rd and Reeves Rd to Panmure (711)
- A new service to connect Otahuhu with Highbrook and Botany (351)
- Improved bus services to Ormiston Town Centre and surrounding suburbs (35, 355)
- More direct bus routes for Bucklands Beach;
 to Panmure (712) and Botany (733), and better
 connections to Half Moon Bay (714)

These changes are part of a simpler, more integrated public transport network that's being implemented for the whole of Auckland by the end of 2018.

Let's get East Auckland moving

Why are we transforming Auckland's bus network?

In the past Auckland's bus network tried to run direct services from everywhere to everywhere mostly at low frequencies, as shown in model 1. We are moving towards model 2, which has fewer routes but higher frequencies and better connections to major centres.


The point where the lines join is where a transfer from bus to bus, or bus to train can be made. Transfers provide access to a much wider range of destinations, and improve frequency and simplicity.


We've already implemented these changes for the Hibiscus Coast, South and West Auckland, and now it's your turn, East Auckland!

Made with your help

In 2015 we ran a detailed survey on the proposed new routes for East Auckland. Thanks to the input of hundreds of residents, East Auckland's new bus network was created.

[TN]: Models 1 and 2 are shown on the next A3 foldout.





Model 1: Direct service option: Many infrequent overlapping routes (Auckland now).

[TN]: Three **Residences** are shown along the top of the diagram and three **Activity Areas** (a shopping area, an office block, and a factory) are depicted in the lower part. Three thin lines run from each residence, leading to each of the activity areas, representing routes. Each line is a different colour.

The pattern created is a criss-cross network.

Model 2: Connective network option: Fewer routes, more frequency (Auckland future).

[TN]: As in Model 1, three **Residences** and three **Activity Areas** are shown. A single thick line leads from each residence, and these meet at a circular **hub** in the middle. From this hub, a single thick line leads to each of the three Activity Areas. The pattern created is a hub with six spokes.

Key benefits

- ✓ More buses more often, 7 days a week

- ✓ Improved connections between buses, trains and ferries, providing access to more destinations.

A new way of travelling to the City Centre

Travel to the City Centre may mean transferring to another bus, train, or ferry.

To make your transfer easier, there will be buses coming more often, and with an AT HOP card you won't pay a separate fare if you have to catch more than one bus or train.

With better bus services to Half Moon Bay and a new ferry timetable, why not try the ferry?

The Night Bus

East Auckland's new Night Bus (70H) replaces the existing N50, and will have a new timetable and a new route, now serving Botany.

From Britomart it will travel via Symonds St, the same as all other East Auckland daytime services.

Be prepared for the first week

With new bus drivers, routes and stops, these big changes may take a few weeks to settle in.

To ensure you get to where you need to, during the first few days we suggest you:

- Give yourself extra time by taking an earlier bus than usual
- Arrive 10 minutes early to your bus stop
- Ensure your bus stop will still be in use, by checking its signage or visit
 AT.govt.nz/newnetworkeast
- With the AT Mobile app you can track your bus or train in real time.

Look out for friendly AT staff on the street to help you in the first week.

Changes to buses in your local area

The New Network replaces all current bus services within East Auckland

Botany

- Buses every 10 minutes on Ti Rakau Dr towards the City Centre, 7 days a week (70)
- Better connections to Howick, with buses every
 15 minutes, 7 days a week (72C, 72M)
- New Monday to Friday, half-hourly route to Otahuhu via Highbrook and every 20 minutes at peak times (351)
- Buses every 15 minutes to Manukau, 7 days a week
 (35)
- No change to route (31)—all day 15 minute service to Otara, Papatoetoe and Mangere Town Centre.
- New bus service via the full length of Botany Rd to meet every ferry* (734)

Half Moon Bay

- New bus service to Botany, via Highland Park and Botany Rd, meeting every ferry sailing* (734)
- All-day bus service to Howick, meeting every ferry sailing* (735)

- New trial bus service from Bucklands Beach, meeting every ferry sailing (including last sailings on Fri and Sat nights) (714)
- For travel towards the City Centre by bus, passengers from Prince Regent Dr and Pigeon Mountain Rd will need to use the (712) via Casuarina Rd, and transfer at Panmure.

Ferry Changes

- From Sunday 10 December, the Half Moon Bay ferry will have a new timetable to improve punctuality and reliability. For details visit www.AT.govt.nz/timetables
- Improvements to the facilities are planned to happen about this time to make transfers between the bus and ferry easier. The new terminal will include new bus stops, bike parking, and an AT HOP top-up machine.

Mission Heights

- New half-hourly bus service to Botany, Ormiston Town Centre and Manukau, 7 days a week (355)
- Passengers going towards the City Centre can connect at Botany to route (70) or to the train at Manukau.
- The current (314) service is changing to connect to Middlemore Station, not Papatoetoe Station.

East Tamaki/Highbrook

- New route connecting Highbrook to Botany and Otahuhu Station (351)
- No changes to existing (353) via Harris Rd, and (31) via Springs Rd.
- Timetable changes to (352) peak only service.

Howick

- Buses to Panmure every 15 minutes all day, 7 days a week (72C) (72M)
- Buses to Botany every 15 minutes via either Chapel
 Rd (72C) or Millhouse Dr (72M) all day, 7 days a week.
- Morning express services to the City Centre and evening peak express services from the City Centre, every 10 minutes (72X). At other times passengers can transfer at Panmure for travel towards the City Centre.
- New bus service connecting Howick and Panmure via Union Rd and Bradbury Rd, running hourly 7 days a week, and every 20 minutes at peak times (711)
- New route serving the full length of Botany Rd, connecting Botany, Highland Park and Half Moon Bay, timed to meet every ferry* (734)
- New bus service from Cockle Bay to Half Moon Bay via Howick, timed to meet every ferry* (735)

Ormiston/Flat Bush

- Buses every 15 minutes all day to Manukau and Botany, 7 days a week (35)
- New half-hourly service on Haddington Dr and Brookview Dr, 7 days a week, and every 20 minutes at peak times (355)
- The current (314) service is changing to connect to Middlemore Station, not Papatoetoe Station.
- Improved service to Beachlands and Maraetai, via Ormiston Rd (739)
- As new roads are built, bus routes will change to better serve Ormiston Town Centre and growing residential areas.

Farm Cove

Half-hourly service to Panmure via Butley Dr,
 Pakuranga Rd and Queens Rd, and every 20 minutes at peak times (712). Transfer at Panmure for travel towards the City Centre.

Pakuranga

- New bus service to Panmure via Reeves Rd, hourly 7 days a week, and every 20 minutes at peak times (711)
- Buses every 15 minutes on Pakuranga Rd to Panmure,
 7 days a week (72C) (72M)

- Buses every 10 minutes on Ti Rakau Dr towards the City Centre, 7 days a week (70)
- No route changes to 352 and 358 services. Timetable changes to 352.

Beachlands and Maraetai

The current 589 is being replaced by a new route (739) to better serve developing areas, and offering:

- Improved frequency, hourly to and from Botany,
 7 days a week.
- A connection between Maraetai and Beachlands in both directions.
- Serves the Ormiston Town Centre.


Bucklands Beach

- More direct route to Panmure via Casuarina Rd and Butley Dr. (712) Transfer at Panmure for travel towards the City Centre.
- New trial bus service to Half Moon Bay, meeting every ferry sailing (including last sailings on Fri and Sat nights) (714)
- More direct route to Botany via Aviemore Dr and Cascades Rd (733)
- Eastern Beach residents will need to use Bucklands Beach Rd bus stops, because buses will no longer travel via Eastern Beach Rd.

At key locations and interchanges your bus may depart from a different stop than before. Check the signage at the stops, or the interchange maps in the timetables, to find out where to catch your bus.







Pay the cheapest fare for your journey with an AT HOP card

Auckland Transport uses a zone-based fare system for all bus and train services, other than SkyBus

The zone map has colour-coded zones across the whole of Auckland. Simply count the number of zones you travel through to work out your fare. When paying with AT HOP on buses and trains your fare is calculated for the whole journey. A single journey can include up to five bus or train trips within four hours as long as there is no more than 30 minutes between each trip. This works out cheaper than paying for each of these trips separately. For the full bus and train fare zones map and current fares visit **AT.govt.nz/fares**.








Example journey

Oui Ming travels by bus and train across three zones from Highland Park to the City Centre every weekday. With her AT HOP card Oui Ming's adult fare is \$4.85. If she paid with cash her total fare would be \$9.00; \$3.50 for one zone fare for the bus plus a \$5.50 two zone fare for the train*.

How this affects buses in surrounding areas

Ellerslie and Great South Rd

- Some Ellerslie Panmure Highway services (500, 501, 550, 551, 552) will be replaced by the (70) which runs every 10 minutes 7 days a week between 7am and 8pm, more often during peak times, and every 15 minutes after 8pm.
- Existing 505, 515, 525, 532, 595 services will not change.
- The 550X will be replaced by the 72X, which operates every 10 minutes at peak times.

Otara, Ormiston, Papatoetoe

 The destination of the 314 service will change from Papatoetoe Station to Middlemore Station, providing a half-hourly connection between Otara and Middlemore, 7 days a week, and every 20 minutes at peak times.

Otahuhu

 The new 351 service (Mon to Fri only) will provide a half-hourly connection to Highbrook and Botany, and every 20 minutes at peak times.

East buses entering the City Centre

When entering and leaving the City Centre, all services will travel via Symonds St to Britomart.

Christmas timetables

Every year, trains, buses and ferries run at reduced frequencies over the holiday. The dates that your service may be affected is between December 25th 2017 and January 7th 2018.

Trains and ferries

There will be no changes to train services or the Pine Harbour ferry sailings at this time. The Half Moon Bay ferry timetable will change from 10 December 2017. Go to AT.govt.nz/timetables for details.

Buses more often to the Airport

The 380 Airporter is doubling* its frequency to every 15 minutes all day, every day.

Now you'll spend less time waiting for the bus and you'll get to work in the Airport precinct quicker or to your flight if you are heading to Auckland Airport for travel.

Connections can be made from East Auckland at Manukau Station or Papatoetoe Station.

AMETI Eastern Busway

Better travel choices and faster, more reliable journeys for East Auckland AMETI* Eastern Busway is a major project in south east Auckland that will significantly improve transport choices, reliability and journey times in the area. Once completed, (estimated for 2026), you will be able to travel by bus and train between Botany and Britomart in less than 40 minutes.

Major transport improvements have already been made with the opening of the new Panmure Station and Te Horeta Rd. The next stage will be construction of a busway with buses travelling on their own congestion free lanes between Panmure and Pakuranga town centres.

The busway will be supported by new cycling and walking connections, urban design enhancements, three new busway stations and improvements for general traffic such as advanced signalling at important intersections.

A new direct road linking Pakuranga Rd with Pakuranga Highway is also planned to provide better travel options and reduce congestion for general traffic.

Modifications to the bus network will be made once the changes are completed, to maximise the benefit of this new infrastructure.




