

MAIN HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS ROUTE:

4 SCHOOL RESERVE

Playground and lovely mature trees providing good shade to picnic beneath. The reserve borders School Road which runs down to connect with the Northwestern Cycleway.

5 NIXON PARK

The park is home to regular basketball, volleyball, rugby, league, and touch rugby games.



6 KINGSLAND

Busy cafés, eateries, and train station, Kingsland has a great tradition of street art and an active community of artists.

11 LEARNING QUARTER

Exit the Grafton Gully cycleway via the wiggly bridge to mid Symonds Street for connection to the Learning Quarter, Art Gallery, Central City Library, Aotea Square, and the centre of town in general.

'Hine' by Owen Dippie marks the start of the Grafton Gully shared path.



9 K' ROAD

Home to an eclectic array of shops, galleries and eateries by day, and a diverse range of cocktail lounges, corner bars, indie music venues and nightclubs. K' Road is an uber cool, utterly outrageous shopping precinct that crosses seamlessly from day to night.

10 GRAFTON BRIDGE

Closed to general traffic, the Grafton Bridge is a great short cut from K' Road to the Hospital, Auckland War Memorial Museum and The Domain.

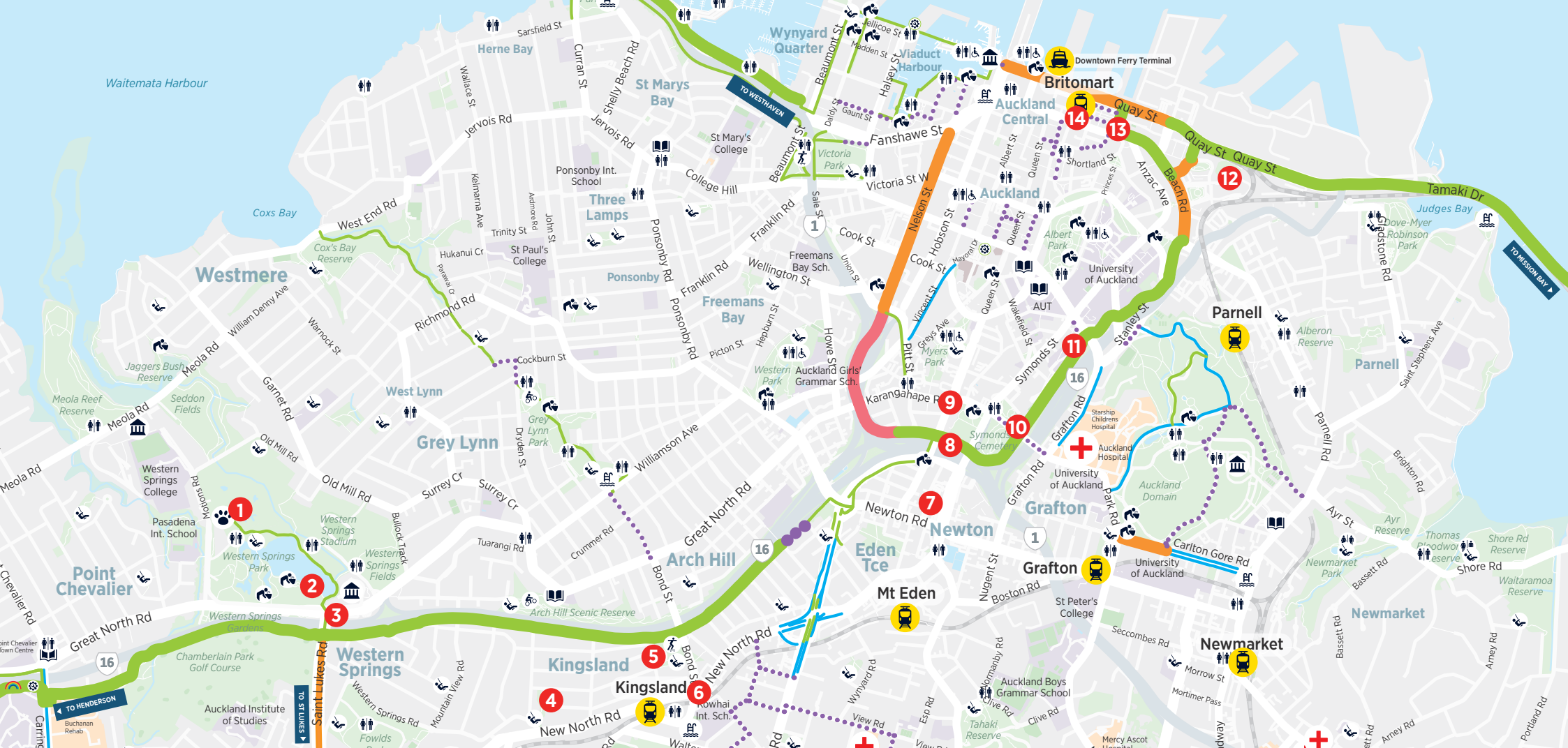
