Business Need

AT has a number of statutory obligations to Māori including the need to establish and maintain a process for Māori to contribute to its decision making process under the Local Government Act. With over 300 infrastructure projects underway, there needs to be a centralised, consistent tool for both AT and Māori to capture and manage engagement on these projects

Solution

Create a solution providing one source of truth to allow management of information about Māori contacts, communications & up to date information on all projects impacting Māori authorities. Reduce the risk of Māori authority information being held by a few key staff members & AT not following appropriate protocol for Māori Engagement.

Outcome


This initiative will help in strengthening the relationship with Māori and also building a partnership of shared knowledge that supports the collaborative creation of solutions to mutual issues
