

KARANGAHAPE ROAD ENHANCEMENTS CONSTRUCTION UPDATE


The Karangahape Road Enhancements project is under way.

Work on the next section of the project, from the Mobil on the corner of Ponsonby and Karangahape Roads, up to the corner of Howe Street, will begin on **Monday 12 August 2019**. This section is expected to take up to five months to complete.

Work along Karangahape Road will be undertaken in sections (see below). During the programme, there will be two to three sections under construction at any given time. The project is expected to be completed in late 2020.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- » Temporary fencing along the footpath at each live construction zone at a minimum height of 1.2m
- » Temporary changes to road layout and parking around construction zones (see overleaf for more information)
- » Ground crew and machinery, including diggers and trucks, will be working within the construction areas
- » Our crews will be working on site during the hours of 7am to 7pm Monday - Saturday.
- » Access to businesses and properties will be maintained

CHANGES TO TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Throughout the project, temporary traffic management will be in place around the live construction sites.

For the safety of road users, pedestrians and our work crews, please carefully follow traffic signage and detours.

Changes at the Ponsonby Road end of Karangahape Road include:

- » Cones and fencing around live construction areas, at a height of 1.2m to 1.8m, as required.
- » Temporary 30km/h speed limit
- » The section of cycleway on Ponsonby Road (by the Mobil) and on Great North Road (on left side approach of the Ponsonby/ Karangahape Road intersection) will be temporarily closed during construction
- » There will be detours in place for works at the intersection of Hereford Street and Karangahape Road
- » Signage/VMS boards advising of detours/traffic changes
- » We will be working with cafes and restaurants to accommodate their al fresco dining where possible
- » We will liaise directly with businesses on alternative loading zones


NIGHT WORKS

There will be occasional lane closures on Karangahape Road for construction across the carriageway. These works will be undertaken at night as Karangahape Road is a main arterial route during the day.

WHAT WE'VE ACHIEVED:

Work at the Symonds St end of Karangahape Road is progressing well. Our work crew has been busy undertaking footpath excavations, removal of the planter boxes along the cemetery wall, kerb and channel removal, and creating foundations for the new street lighting.

As part of Auckland Council's Symonds Street cemetery path upgrade, the path through Pigeon Park will be temporarily closed for construction. A temporary path will be provided for pedestrians along our fencing.
