Conduct of vessels

- 1) No vessel of 500 gross tonnage or greater shall operate, test or otherwise use any manoeuvring or propulsion equipment without a pilot onboard unless the vessel has the prior written permission of the Harbourmaster.
- 2) The Master and/or Pilot of a vessel of 500 gross tonnage or greater when testing propulsion or manoeuvring equipment within the Downtown Ferry Terminal Basin shall broadcast an “all ships” warning on VHF Ch 12 prior to undertaking the testing, and a further message to confirm completion of the test.
- 3) The Master and/or Pilot of a vessel of 500 gross tonnage or greater having completed a berthing manoeuvre, or about to commence a departure manoeuvre within the Down Town Ferry Terminal Basin shall broadcast an “all ships” message on VHF Ch 12 stating the fact.
- 4) Between the hours of 07:30 to 09:00 hours and 16:30 to 18:00 hours daily (excluding Saturday and Sunday);
 - a) No vessel of 500 gross tonnage or greater shall;
 - i) Manoeuvre within the downtown ferry terminal basin,
 - ii) Operate any propulsion or manoeuvring equipment.

Limitations

Every vessel shall observe maritime rules, bylaws and codes:

- i) Maritime Rule 22; and
- ii) Auckland Council Navigation Safety Bylaws; and
- iii) Harbourmaster Directions.
