



## How many ways can you get to school?

Transactional writing - List

Suitable: Level 1 – Guided

WALT: List all the ways we can get to school.

### Definition:

A list is a number of items or names that are connected and placed one after the other.

### Activity

#### Brainstorm

List all the different ways you can get to and from school.

Example: walk, cycle, scoot, skateboard, car, bus, walking school bus, train etc...

Now talk about the advantages (good things) and disadvantages (bad things) about each of those forms of transport.

### Discussion: Compare and Contrast

Name what is the same or different about each of these ways of getting to and from school.

### Picture

Choose one type of transport (e.g. car, bike, scooter) and draw a picture of it. Then label what it is.

### Extension:

Talk about what the words **active** and **sustainable** mean.

- **Active:** to move physically.
- **Sustainable:** to continue doing something regularly / over time.
