

Travelwise Brochure

Transactional writing Suitable: Level 2,3,4

WALT: Create a brochure that has the following elements:

- a description of each type of transport used
- an illustration that supports the text
- a map/diagram of the local area

Definition

A brochure is a small book or magazine that contains pictures and details about a place, a product or a service. It provides people with information about something.

Activity

Brainstorm

List 3 different types of brochures you have seen before.

Example: Travel, health brochure, sales

Create your own brochure

Brochures are a great way to advertise and promote things. Create your own Travelwise brochure promoting 3 different ways to travel to and from school in an active or sustainable way. You might consider a range of travel options such as; walking, cycling, scooting, skateboarding, roller blading, bus, train etc...

What to do: (alternatively try this on a computer)

- 1. Take a piece of paper or cardboard and fold it into thirds.
- 2. On the front create a title page.
- 3. Add the name of your school and the address.
- 4. Then choose your 3 travel options.
- 5. Create a section (space) for each one.
- 6. Add a title and picture to illustrate each.
- 7. Make it nice and colourful.
- 8. Write a description underneath to explain what type of travel it is and what the benefits (advantages) of travelling that way are.

Extension

Add extra pages including:

- a map or diagram of your local area.
- include some symbols that show parks, paths, crossings (e.g. zebra/kea, signalised lights) and walkways.
