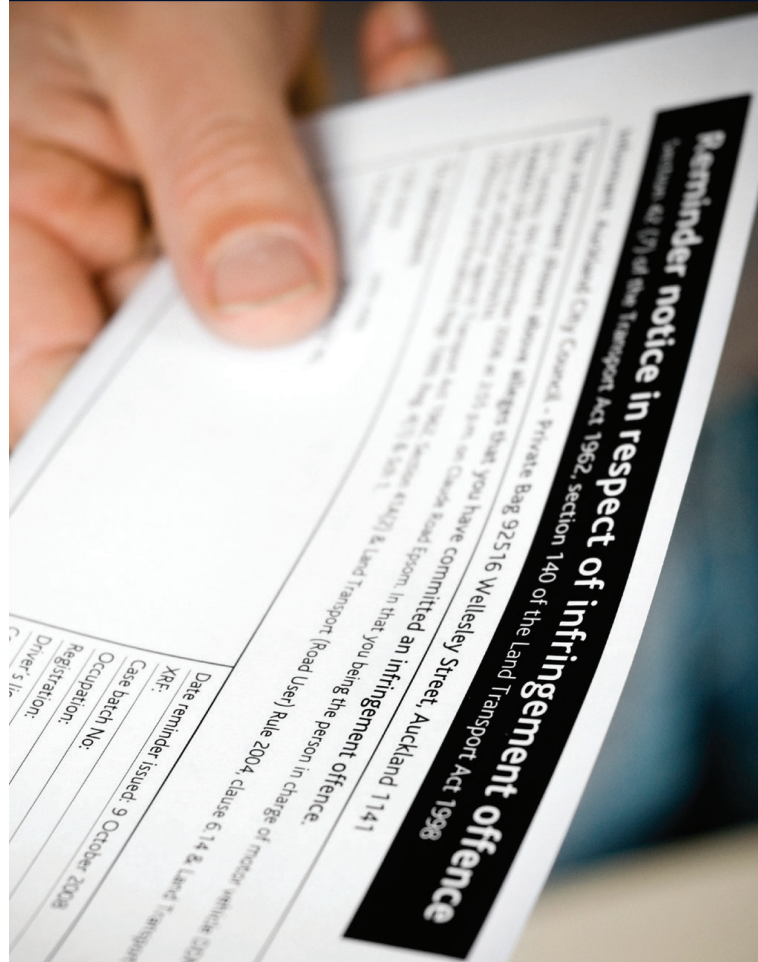

Court hearing request

Your options



Options available to you

1 Pay the infringement fee without any additional charges

If you pay the infringement fee before the notice is lodged at court, no further action or additional costs will be incurred. Please turn to the back of this brochure for easy ways to pay.

2 Request for court hearing – Guilty plea

If you accept liability for the offence(s), but want the court to take into account your submissions before imposing a fine you should complete the attached form and return it with all material you want the court to consider. Auckland Transport will file your request and the attached documents with the court on your behalf.

You do not need to appear in court for sentencing. Justices of the Peace will consider your submissions and you will be notified of the result. However if you wish to appear at sentencing please ensure you clearly indicate that request on the attached form.

Please note that if you elect to be sentenced by the court (whether you choose to appear or not), the court is able to impose a fine of up to \$500, and must also impose court costs in addition to any fine imposed.

3 Request for court hearing – Not guilty plea

If you do not accept liability for the offence(s) and want a trial, you should complete and return the attached form.

This option requires you to appear in court. On your first appearance you will be asked to formally enter your plea. If you plead not guilty a trial date will be set for another day where Justices of the Peace will hear the evidence and determine whether the offence(s) are proven.

Please note that if the court finds the offence(s) proven, the court is able to impose a fine of up to \$500 on each offence, and must also impose court costs in addition to any fine imposed.
