



# **Diamond Ranking Chart – Transport and the Future**

Social Science / English Suitable: Level 2, 3, 4 – Guided / Shared / Independent WALT: Explore problems / questions involving transport and create possible solutions to address the issue. Assess an issue and rank it according to different perspectives (e.g. personal, family, school, business, government).


The **Diamond Ranking Chart** is a tool that you can use when you have a problem or question you want to work through. You brainstorm your ideas and then rank them in order of importance in a diamond pattern.

#### What to do?

- Pose your problem or question.
- Brainstorm all your solutions.
- Rank your ideas in order of the *most important* to the *least important*.
- Place them on the chart from the single most important idea at the top to the single least important at the bottom.

## Activity

- 1. Create your own Diamond Ranking Chart.
- 2. Choose a question from the list below and work through the steps above.

*Tip*: Write your ideas on small pieces of paper or Post-it notes so that you can move them around easily.

## **Question:**

- Will the transport we use now have a long term effect on the environment? If so, why / why not?
- What types of transport will exist in 50 years from now and how will it change the way we travel?
- Will transport change the way communities look in the future?

Explain why you ranked your ideas this way.

### Extension

Now take your ideas and rank them on the chart from a different perspective.

Try looking at the same issue as if you were a:

- family
- school
- business
- government
