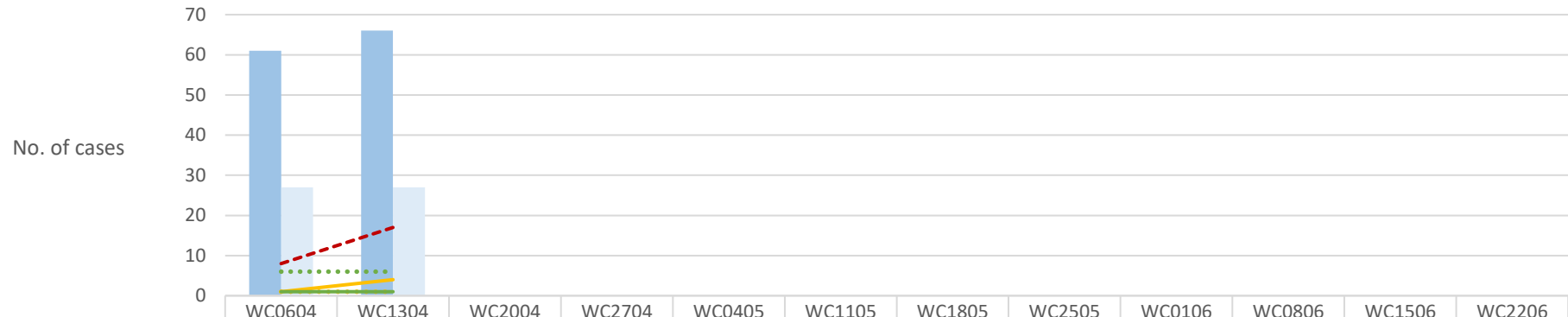

NOTES FOR DATA CAPTURE:

1. The data presented by the graph above starts at 13 April 2020 but includes data previously captured.
2. The margin of error for the presented data relates to the accuracy of reporting within Synergi – the current non-negative case has not been captured in Synergi at this stage.
3. The data has been presented as Internal (e.g. AT employees – solid lines) and External (e.g. contractors and operators – dotted lines) and has also been overlaid with a red dotted line signifying occasions where non-essential journeys were undertaken on Public Transport thereby putting AT staff at increased risk.
4. The data is presented with running totals and will include other criteria (e.g. undergoing testing, tested non-negative, etc.) once cases are created. Trends will also start to develop over time as the numbers of staff in self-isolation decrease, etc.
