What's happening?

Auckland Transport is proposing to set new permanent speed limits for 26 roads in Auckland's west and north. The proposed new limits will support travel speeds that are safe and appropriate for the function, design and use of the roads.

We have identified 26 roads in the following areas that need new safe and appropriate speed limits:

- Swanson
- Massey
- Warkworth
- Matakana
- Tāwharanui Peninsula

Please turn over to see the list of roads (or sections of roads) that we propose changing the speed limits on.

If these proposed changes go ahead, they will be made by amendment to the Speed Limits Bylaw 2019 and come into effect within the next year. The bylaw was made by Auckland Transport in 2019. New permanent speed limits came into force on a number of roads around Auckland on 30 June 2020.
