	The EGM Planning and Investment introduced Mr Fleming who presented the paper and recommended that the committee support the continuation of the Regional Fuel Tax (RFT) Scheme.	
	Discussion ensued around the issue of regional equity for provision of transport and that Auckland Council will look at the RFT through a regional equity lens.	
	Ms Daly asked which projects had been confirmed for RFT funding. In response, Mr Fleming indicated that this was still to be decided but outlined proposed projects had been included in the briefing pack provided for this session. Auckland Transport (AT) will work with council on projects for inclusion which will then be subject to Council decision. The projects reflected prioritisation under the draft Regional Land Transport Plan 2021 - 2031 (RLTP), aligned with the 14 RFT Projects.
