# On the draft 10-year plan for Auckland's transport network

## Draft 2021-2031 Regional Land Transport Plan (RLTP)

The RLTP is the 10-year plan for Auckland's transport network. It details the areas that Auckland Transport, Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency and KiwiRail will focus on to respond to our region's transport challenges. It also outlines the proposed 10-year investment programme for specific transport projects.

### Transport Challenges



#### Climate change and the environment

Emissions and other effects of Auckland's transport system are harming the environment and contributing to the transport system becoming increasingly susceptible to the impacts of climate change.



#### Safety

People being seriously injured and killed on our transport system is not acceptable.



#### Access

As our population increases, our roads are getting more congested and it's taking longer to travel to places. Further development of our transport network is needed to provide better access to employment and social opportunities for more people.



#### Travel choices

Better and faster public transport options are needed to give Aucklanders more choices in the way they travel. Congestion will continue to get worse if we don't provide more desirable transport options than the car.

### Regional Fuel Tax (RFT)

Auckland Council is currently seeking feedback on a proposal to vary their current RFT scheme in response to funding decisions made by Government and to align with the draft RLTP.

### How the draft RLTP responds to Auckland's transport challenges



#### Climate change and the environment

Making the transport system more environmentally friendly with electric and hydrogen buses and other electric transport options.



#### Travel choices

Accelerating better travel choices by providing rapid transit that is fast, frequent and high capacity - separated from general traffic. We also plan to provide new and more frequent rail services and improve accessibility at bus, train and ferry facilities.



#### Safety

Making the transport system more forgiving of the mistakes people make to prevent serious harm.



#### Better transport connections and roading

Measures to address congestion like new or widened roads, bus and transit lanes as well as walking and cycling facilities.



#### Growth

Providing transport infrastructure to support new housing developments and growth areas.



#### Asset management

Fixing and maintaining footpaths, local roads, state highways and the rail network.



#### Other items

Local Board programmes, planning for the future, technology and organisational improvement initiatives.
