




### **Total boardings**



#### Notes:


- Boardings were being manually counted by drivers until 15 Aug 20. As a result, no alighting information is available between 5 July and 15 August 2020.

  Additionally, some trips had missing data on many days indicating that not all passengers were being recorded. Manual counting was conducted on some trips to cross check the recorded numbers.
- Tag off information is available from 16 August 2020.
- Highest boardings recorded till date is 758 on 29 April 2021.
- \* Train services began running at lower frequencies and slower speeds with KiwiRail's track repair works starting from 17 August 2020.



The table below is a comparison of the boardings per service hour of bus service 64 with bus services 20 and the OuterLink, two other nearby bus routes with similar frequencies.

#### Notes

- Boardings per service hour are our main indicator of how cost effective a bus service is. Boardings are the sum of recorded passengers paying with an AT HOP card or purchasing a paper ticket on weekdays (excluding holidays).
- Cash fares have not been accepted on buses since 23 March 2020 due to Covid 19 physical distancing measures. While AT has been encouraging people to purchase and use an AT HOP card to pay for their bus trip, people expecting to pay with cash are accepted onto buses and their boarding is not recorded.
- Boarding figures during Alert Levels 4,3,2 were not used in target measurements.
- "Service hours" are the sum of the scheduled duration of all trips (weekdays excluding holidays)
- Regional Public Transport Plan (RPTP) target ranges for weekday boardings-per-service-hour were published in <u>Auckland Transport's</u>
   2018 -2028 Regional Public Transport Plan.
- Route 64 doesn't have a boardings per service hour target. It is a long-term temporary route, launched as a result of Mt Eden Station closure due to City Rail Link (CRL) construction, largely funded by the City Rail Link project.
- As at May 2021, all Auckland bus routes are currently operating at 75% of their pre-Covid 19 patronage. Patronage is lower due to more
  people working from home (even in Alert Level 1), fewer international students and tourists, mistrust of public spaces and public transport
  in particular (more private car trips are being made now than pre-Covid 19) and trains being canceled and delayed due to ongoing track
  maintenance work.
