We would like to thank you for your patience while this important safety work is completed.



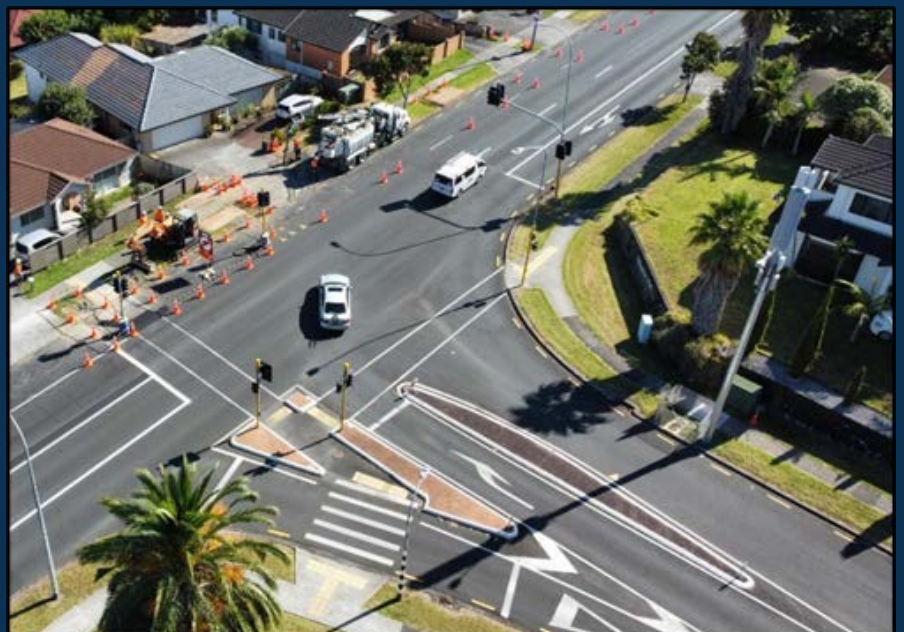

PROJECT OVERVIEW

To install a dedicated right turn bay at the intersection of Chapel Road & Kilkenny Drive.

This is being constructed by widening the existing intersection and creating two dedicated northbound lanes.

The surrounding footpath will be widened, and a raised speed table installed for the crossing on the Kilkenny Drive slip lane.

Last Week

Ventia on behalf of Auckland Transport (AT) kicked off the project on Monday 14th March. Completing new line marking, locating the underground services and upgrading street lights and installing two new catchpits to assist with drainage.

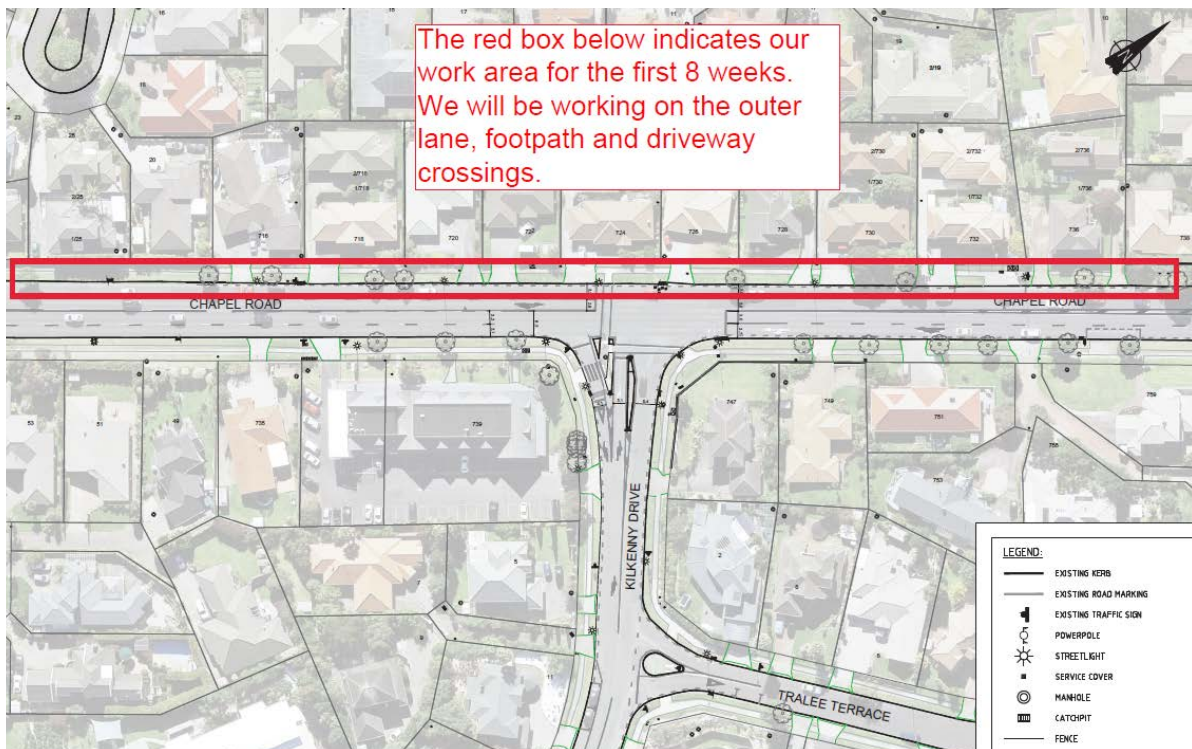
This Week

All works are weather dependant. This week, commencing the 21st March Ventia will be continuing drainage and starting on pavement and concrete excavations to allow for the road widening.
