Buy an AT HOP card

To travel on Auckland Transport's buses, trains and ferries, you'll need to buy an AT HOP card.

An AT HOP card is a reusable pre-paid travel card that you top up and use to pay for your journeys.



Load some money onto your new AT HOP card to begin using it


No cash is accepted on Auckland Transport buses.



Head to the Take Home shop in the airport and buy one at the counter

Follow the exit sign which says 'Transport', then you'll see the shop on your right.

Find your way with the AT Journey Planner

Need directions to get to your accommodation?

Download the AT Mobile app or visit our website to use the AT Journey Planner. The Journey Planner will show you all the transport options available and how much they'll cost.

Don't have any data?

No worries. Chat with your AirportLink bus driver or talk to our friendly staff at the Customer Service Centre at Puhinui Station.

You will also find a map and route information at the bus stop.





Got your AT HOP card? Great!

Head outside and find the AirportLink bus.

Follow the signs marked **'Transport'** out of the building, then cross the road and continue walking to your left, following the orange markers on the ground until you reach the bus stop.

The bus will take you to Puhinui Station where you can travel anywhere on the AT network; or if you're heading South you can stay on the AirportLink until Manukau to connect to bus services.

You can also take the 38 bus, which runs between Auckland Airport and Onehunga via Mangere Town Centre.

Use your AT HOP card to tag on

Ready to jump on the bus?

When you board the bus, hold your AT HOP card against the reader (pictured below) until you hear a beep.

Do the same thing when you exit the bus.

Congratulations, you've just tagged on and tagged off for the first time!





Find us when the jetlag's gone

Once you've settled into your accommodation, we know you'll be ready to head out and explore.

Need to top up?

Visit AT.govt.nz/retailers to find your nearest HOP retailer or visit your local train station and use the top-up machine there to load more money to your card.



You can use your AT HOP card on buses, trains and ferries. Time to head out and explore.



How much will my trip cost?

Auckland is divided into different fare zones

We calculate how much your trip will cost based on the number of zones you travel through. This means it doesn't matter what form of transport you use, or how many times you transfer, only how far you travel.

If you are traveling to Britomart in the city centre you can expect to pay \$5.40 from the airport. The main city centre train station is called Britomart.

The fares are listed on the Journey Planner and AT Mobile app

Remember you need tag on and off for every stage/leg of your journey to get charged correctly.

Keep your card topped up

Offline

You can top up in person at selected train stations, ferry terminals and bus stations, either using the machine or the Customer Service Centre, or you can top up at selected retailers across the city.

In person top ups are immediate so you can travel straight away.

Online

You can top up online on the AT website or in the AT Mobile app (you need to register your card first).

This needs to be done the night before for bus travel or an hour ahead of time for train and ferry travel.
