

VIADUCT CYCLEWAY & ENHANCEMENTS PROGRESS UPDATE

12 October 2022

We are working hard to make up for earlier delays and plan to complete work on the intersection of Customs Street West and Market Place late next week.

So we can complete all main construction work before the Christmas period begins in early December, we have devised an accelerated construction plan. We will work in multiple areas at the same time to get the work done as efficiently and quickly as possible. Work includes:

Customs Street West (harbour side) - reinstate cycleway, install seating, bike racks and planters. Install a mobility ramp by the toilet block.

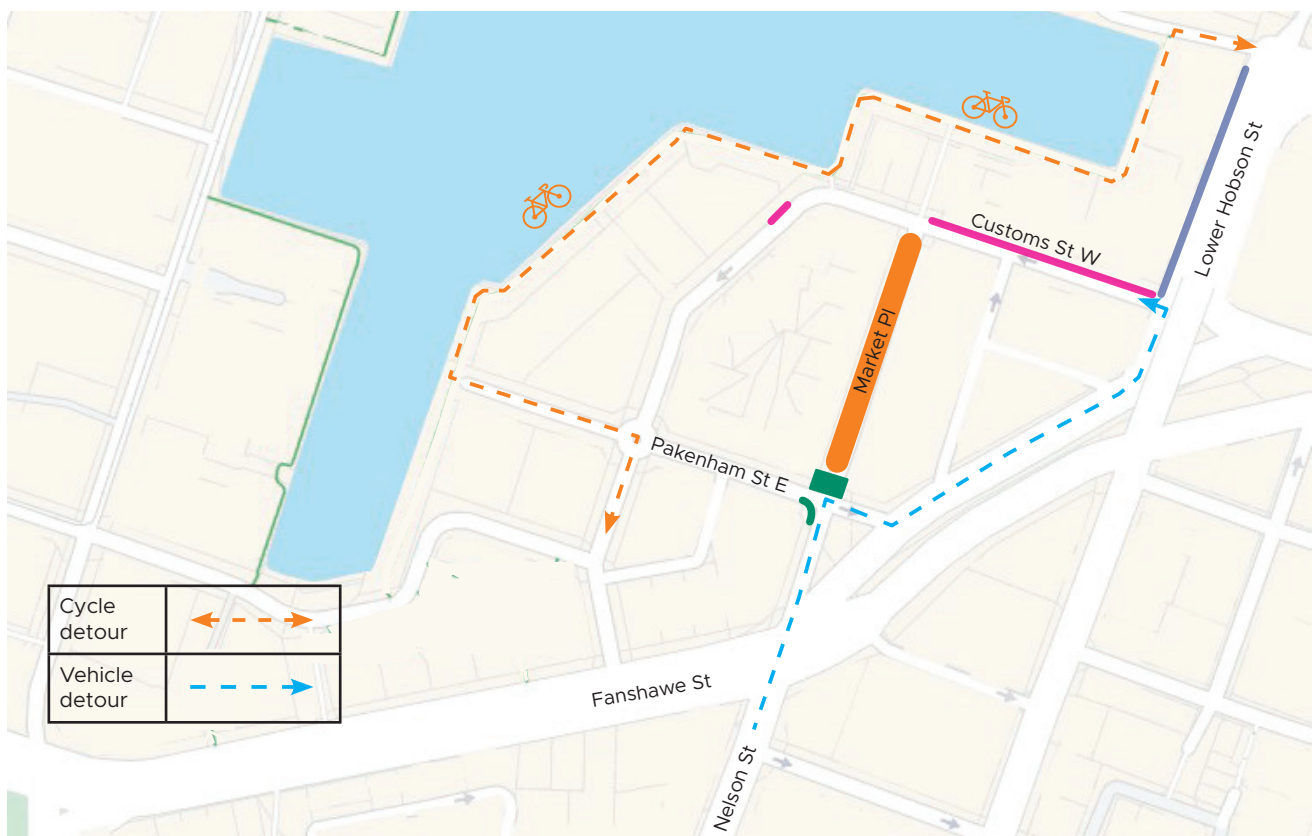
Market Place & Pakenham Street East intersection – upgrade stormwater, extend the kerb on the corner near Salt Café and install a raised pedestrian crossing on Market Place to improve safety.

Market Place – tree pit renewal, resurfacing, switch the cycleway to the western (apartment) side.

Lower Hobson Street – upgrade the cycleway, loading zone, line-marking and signage.

What to expect:

- Market Place and Customs Street West intersection will be open and Customs Street West will return to one-way traffic flow.
- Detours will be in place (see map below). Vehicle access into Market Place will be from Customs Street West only.
- Loading zone access - there will be a temporary loading zone on Lower Hobson Street.
- Footpaths will be kept open and access to residential properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.
