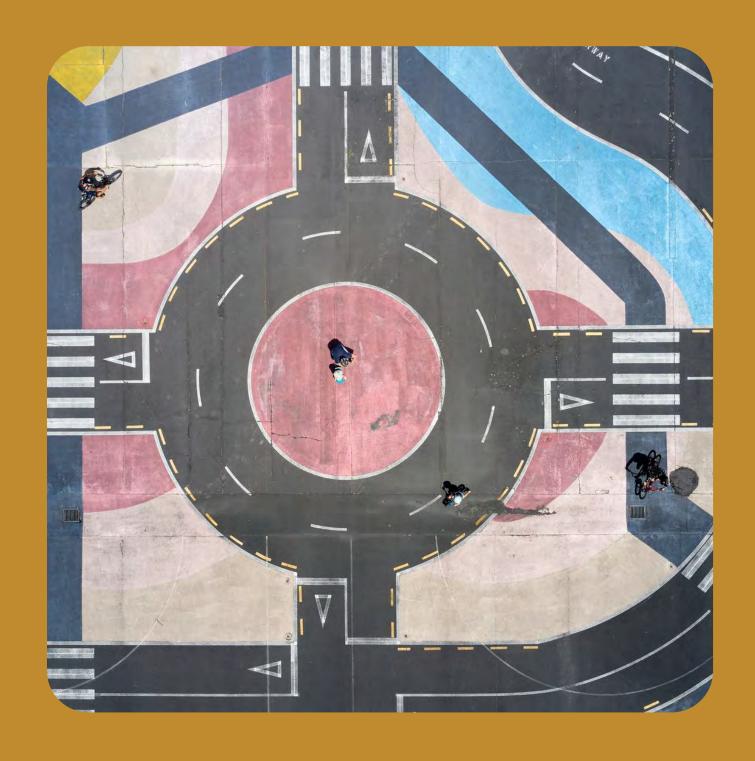

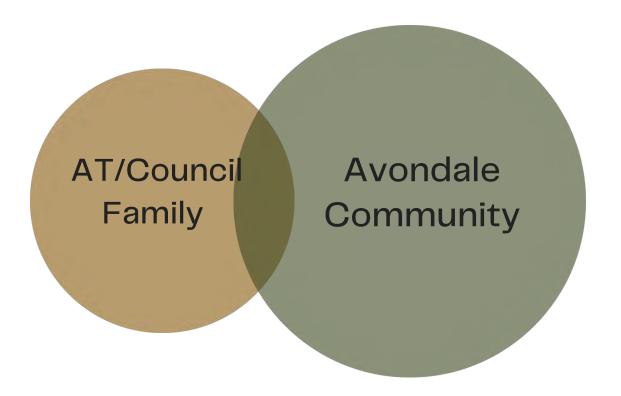

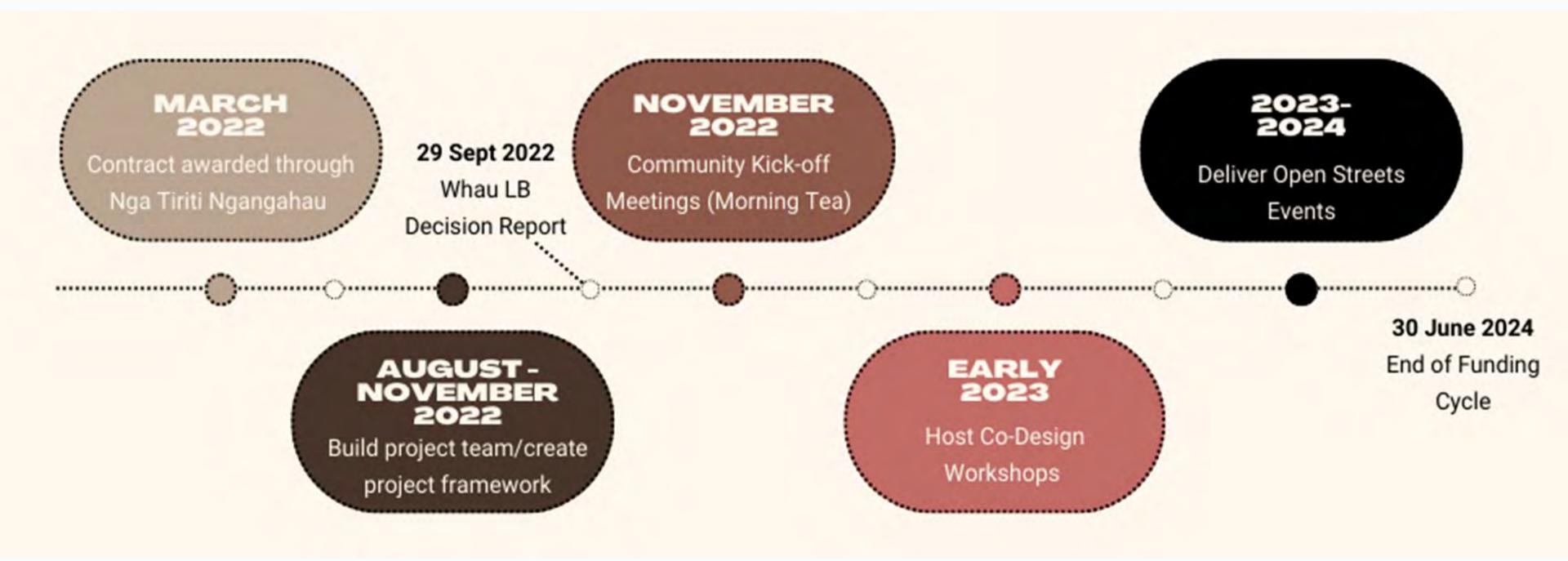

crowds

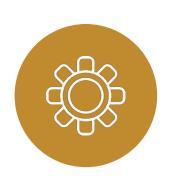

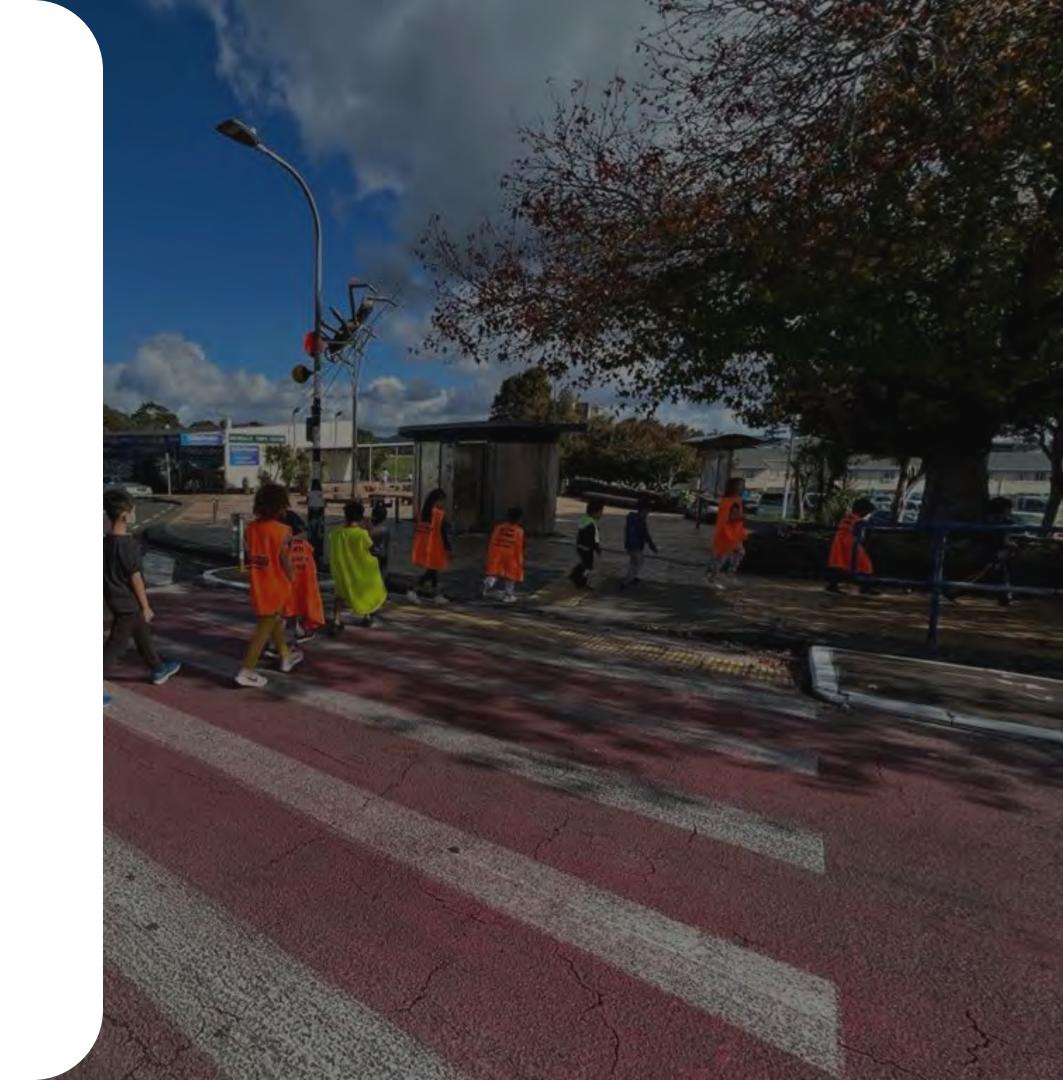
