Drainage remedial work

To resolve the pooling of water around the intersection of Market Place and Customs Street West, new drainage will be installed in the footpath. This work is due to start on **Thursday 2 February 2023** and is expected to take two weeks to complete. It will take place on two corners of the intersection. One corner will be worked on at a time (refer to map).


What to expect

1 Half of the footpath near the road side will be closed. However, pedestrian access will be maintained on the cafe side of the footpath.

A section of footpath around our works will be closed and pedestrians will be directed to the other side of the road.

All roads and the cycleway will remain open at all times.

This work is weather dependent and may be postponed in the event of bad weather.



Streetlight work

New streetlights will be installed later in February. Details of this work will be provided closer to the time.
