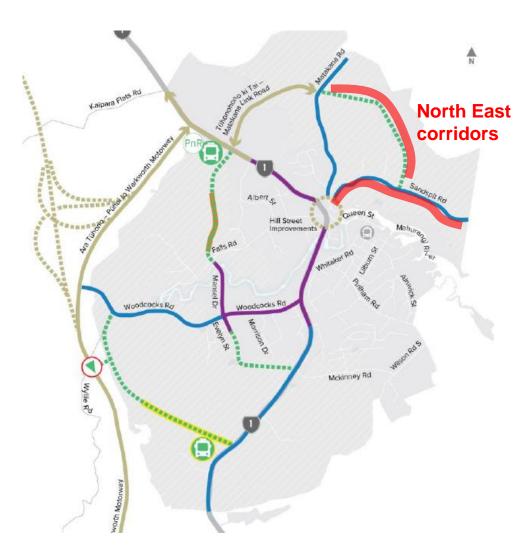

<sup>\*\*</sup>The BCR is based on the standard evaluation methods for transport infrastructure, which is typically dominated by travel time savings. The purpose of many of the Warkworth projects are primarily about providing the basic infrastructure to make growth happen such as urbanising existing rural roads. These types of corridors have high costs but relatively small transport benefits (primarily walk/cycle benefits), and exclude other, un-monetised benefits that would also arise from 'urbanisation'. The bulk of transport benefits for the Warkworth network therefore come from completing new links to enable the land use to develop.
