## The Parade - Stage One

Our contractor Dempsey Wood is set to start work on traffic calming and pedestrian approvements along The Parade in Buckland Beach.

Where	Laings Road to Whitcombe Road intersection on The Parade
Start date	2 September 2024
Hours of work	7am to 7pm
Duration	Approximately 4 weeks (weather dependent)

# The work we're doing.

We are doing this work to make the area safer for all road users. Construction was initially planned for October 2023 but was put on hold due to unforeseen circumstances. We understand that a letter drop was previously conducted in September 2023.

We sincerely apologise for any inconvenience caused by the delay and any resulting uncertainty.

This work will be carried out in **two stages**.

# Stage One:

This work will involve:

- A full road closure and detours. Resident access will be maintained.
- Installing a concrete raised pedestrian near the Laings Road intersection
- Installing 3 speed humps between Laings Road and Whitcombe Road
- Line marking works (may be carried out over two nights 7pm 7am)
- Installing new streetlighting
- New signage works

We'll do our best to start the work on time. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we'll notify you.

If we need to carry out night work, We know this can be a bit loud and disruptive and we will do our best to keep noise levels down. We try our best to avoid working at night but sometimes it is necessary to avoid wider disruption on the network or to get the job done faster.

The map overleaf shows where we'll be working and the detour route.

### We'll handle traffic flow in and out of the area.

You'll need to reduce your speed when you're driving through the area. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.



We will need to close the road and set up detours. Please plan ahead and think about using another route We'll set up signs that give traffic directions for surrounding roads.

If you live somewhere along a closed road, traffic controllers at either end of the road will help you.

Ground conditions mean that, in some places, construction activity may create noticeable vibrations. Any vibrations will be kept within the limits of our resource consent; however, it may be prudent to secure unstable items.

## **Stage Two:**

Will be carried out at a later stage; we will provide an updated letter with further information to nearby properties once we have confirmed the date.


