We're starting new work on Carrington Road

Kia ora,

We're starting work in new areas on Carrington Road between 7 September to late December 2026. The first stage will include stormwater investigations and main works at the intersection of Carrington Road and Willcott Street, as well as kerb and channel upgrades between 159 and 195 Carrington Road.

Unexpected site conditions or wet weather may cause delays. If there is a significant delay, we will let you know. Scan the QR code for more project details, or subscribe to our newsletter for updates on future stages.



Here is what you need to know about the work near you:

Where	Carrington Road, between Willcott Avenue and Woodward Road
When	- From 7 September to late December 2026 - Dayworks: Monday to Saturday 7:30am to 6:00pm - Nightworks: If nightworks are required, we will notify you.
What we're doing	Stormwater upgrades, kerb and channel upgrades, utilities work and new bus stops
How it may impact you	Property access: From 7 September, driveway access will be limited during work hours for properties between 159 and 195 Carrington Road. This is expected to last about three weeks while we upgrade the kerb and channel. As part of this work, we will pour new concrete for the kerb and channel. When this happens, vehicle access will be closed for one night while the concrete dries. A later stage of work will include footpath construction, which will also affect driveway access. We will provide more information before this stage begins. You will still be able to walk to your property at all times. We will confirm any vehicle access restrictions with you at least <u>two days</u> before they happen. Work locations may change as construction progresses. Please make sure Dempsey Wood has your current contact details so we can keep you updated. On-street parking: From 14 September, on-street parking between 157–195 Carrington Road will be removed. This parking will not return for the remainder of the project. Noise and vibration: The work will create some noise and vibration. We will monitor this and do our best to keep noise levels down where possible.
How travel is affected	Traffic management: Traffic management in Zone 4 will alternate between road closures and one-way detours on side streets. Further details will be provided. Speed reduction: A temporary speed limit of 30km/h will be in place. Please take care while sharing the road with people on bikes. Bus stops: Some bus stops in Zone 4 will be closed during the work. Signs will show the nearest alternative bus stop, and this information will also be available on AT Journey Planner.
