There are many ways you can use QR Codes to motivate any class lesson. First you need to generate codes with either, questions, answers, links or general information.

- 1 Try having a worksheet of questions with the answers on the QR Code hidden in a confined region.
- 2 Try having a code with a question and a clue where to find the next code. On the next code have the answer, the next question and the next clue.
- 3 Try having a question on each code and an internet link to sites that may contain the answers.

Down load a QR Code reader to use on your smart phone or ipads.
