We need to do some work on SH16 at night

Kia ora,

We're planning to do some nighttime road renewal work on State Highway 16 between Trigg Road and the railway bridge just before Tapu Road for about five nights beginning the evening of Sunday, 28 July 2024.

This work is part of our ongoing project to upgrade the roading infrastructure at State Highway 16 and Station Road to serve the growing community around Huapai Triangle Special Housing Area. It will take place at nighttime hours, between 7pm to 6am. We'll have a stop/go traffic operation running during the work period.

The work we're doing

With the project progressing well, we're going to be resurfacing SH16 between Trigg Rd and the railway bridge just before Tapu Road with new asphalt so that it better connects with the new road infrastructure we're building and continues serving the growing Huapai community for years to come.

This work will be undertaken at nighttime to reduce the impact on commuters. We'll have a stop/go traffic operation in the work area. If you are travelling at nighttime, we ask that you allow extra time for travel and follow the signs and directions of the traffic management crew on site.

We'll do our best to start the work on time. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we'll notify you.

We know our work can be a bit loud, and that noise – particularly at night – can be disrupting. We try our best to avoid working at night, but sometimes it is necessary in order to avoid wider disruption on the network or to get the job done faster. When we have to work at night, we do our best to keep noise levels down.
