Share with Care

Traffic lanes have been moved to make room for the works on either side of road, line markings have been removed and replaced with temporary marking- the layout will change during construction as required.

Slow down!

This corridor is now **30km/h** posted speed limit and is a shared zone for vehicles and cycles.

This temporary speed limit is being enforced by the Police



Drop-off Pick-up parking for Gladstone School

Due to the changes on Carrington Road the P5 drop-off/pick up parking adjacent to Gladstone School has been removed and replaced with P15 parking on Fifth Ave 8am-9am and 2.30pm-3.30pm

Construction during the school holidays

During the June/July school holidays, we may be able to complete some extra work while the area is quieter. If it goes ahead, we'll let affected residents and businesses know by sending a separate letter with the details.

Rubbish collection

Residents should continue to put rubbish and recycling out as normal on collection days. We will work closely with Auckland Council to manage waste pickups as work areas progress. For more information head to:

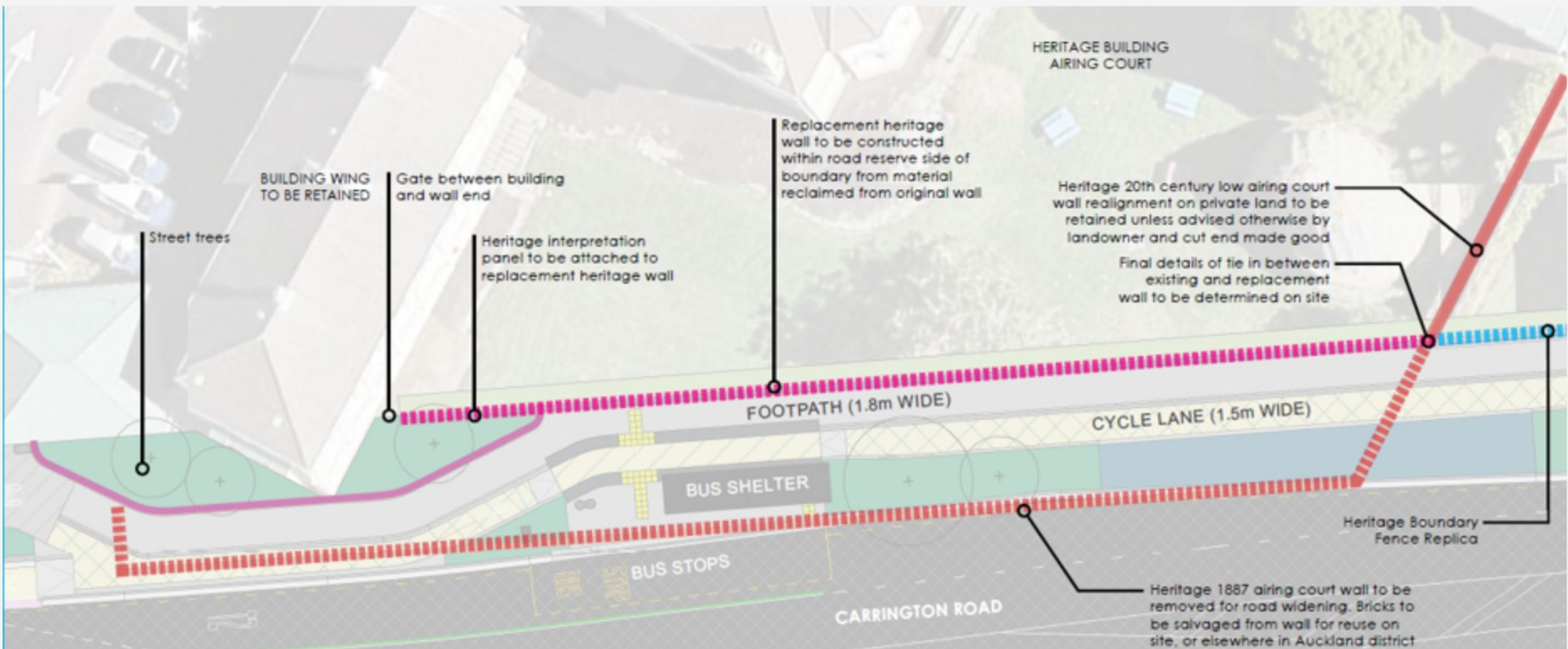

Moving the Carrington Hospital historic wall

As a condition of the resource consent for the Carrington Road Improvement project, Auckland Transport is required to deconstruct, move and re-build the historic wall on the new boundary line. This will be approximately 8 metres west of its current location. Designed by the Government Architect Charles Beaton and built in 1887, Carrington Hospital was once a key part of the social fabric of Auckland, providing mental health services until it closed in 1993.

Deconstruction of this wall will take place early July

Construction date change

The Sutherland Road traffic setup planned for the 29 June – 31 July has been pushed out. We will update directly impacted residents and include the new start date in July's construction update.

Cyclist and pedestrian crossing changes

We have moved the lower Carrington Road pedestrian and cyclist crossing close to its new final location due to the works that will be starting in Sutherland Road. This crossing while temporary, has been marked with green cyclist signage and the required pedestrian signage, and reflective markers.

There are three new temporary crossings across Carrington Road due to the footpath closure on the western side so people can access bus stops and businesses - these crossings and have been marked with the required pedestrian signage and lighting.

Please note temporary crossings will be relocated throughout the project delivery to ensure they are suitably placed.
