<p>Ahuroa Road, Warkworth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Install a footpath stretching approximately 60 metres to connect Ahuroa School to the Ahuroa Community Hall on the western side • Trim trees on the footpath area to improve visibility 	Delivered in September 2023
<p>Point Wells Road, Warkworth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Install a footpath stretching approximately 85 metres from property 38 Point Wells Road to Waimanu Place bus stop • Relocate existing post boxes outside properties 40 to 52 Point Wells Road to the edge of the new footpath 	Delivered in September 2023
<p>Olympus Road, Wellsford</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Install a footpath stretching approximately 100 metres on the northeastern side, from 2 Olympus Road to 55 Station Road. 	Delivered in September 2023

<p>Koraha/Oraha Road, Kumeu</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Install a footpath that will extend from Oraha Road to Weza Lane • Install a new refuge island along Oraha Road that will allow people to safely wait when crossing the road • Paint broken yellow lines at the corner of Oraha and Koraha Road, Weza Lane and Koraha Road to prevent vehicles from parking and provide visibility at the intersection • Remove a total of 28 trees to make way for the footpath and will soon replace them through Auckland Council • Build kerb and channels at small portions along Koraha Road • Install giveaway markings and pram crossing at the corner of Weza Lane and Koraha Road • Reconstruct vehicle crossings impacted by the new footpath 	Construction is scheduled in July 2024

Riverhead Road, Kumeu	Currently on the design stage
Separable Portion 3	
<p>School Road, Warkworth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extend the existing footpath at the corner of School Road and Kaipara Flats Road by 90 metres. • Install a raised zebra crossing outside 12 School Road to improve the safety of children crossing the road especially during busy hours. • Install tactile pavers at the approaches to the crossing. Tactile pavers are yellow guidance paving markers that help the visually impaired find their way to the crossing. • Install signs to inform pedestrians and drivers of the new raised crossing. • Paint broken yellow lines (no stopping at all times) at the Kaipara Flats Road and School Road intersection. • Install a new berm on the stretch of the new footpath at the corner of School Road and Kaipara Flats Road. 	Construction is scheduled in March 2024
<p>Kaipara Flats Road, Warkworth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Construct a footpath between 966 Kaipara Flats Road and 988 Kaipara Flats Road. • Install pram crossings with tactile pavers outside 966 and 1 Kaipara Flats Road. • Paint broken yellow lines from 980 to 952 Kaipara Flats Road and 963 to 957 Kaipara Flats Road. 	Construction is scheduled in March 2024
<p>Old Woodcocks Road, Warkworth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extend the existing footpath near the corner of Old Woodcocks Road and Kaipara Flats Road to outside 21 Old Woodcocks Road. 	Construction is scheduled in March 2024
Mckinney Road, Warkworth	Currently on the design stage

<p>Mason Heights, Warkworth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Install a footpath along the northern side of Mason Heights, between Woodcocks Road and Jamie Lane• Upgrade the stormwater drainage and install new kerb and channel along this section of the road• Install lighting along the new footpath• Reconstruct vehicle crossings impacted by the new footpath	<p>Construction scheduled in July 2024</p>
