We're improving safety and accessibility for people walking, riding and using a bus between Point Chevalier town centre and the Westmere shops. The project is under construction and will be completed end of June 2025.

- Add seating and rubbish bins
- Provide a great environment for outdoor dining
- •Improve stormwater drainage

- •Rebuild Meola Road's foundations (completed)
- Move Meola Road powerlines underground
- •Improve bus travel times
- •Improve pedestrian access to Meola Reef Reserve
- •Improve harbour water quality by separating stormwater and wastewater pipes
- Enhance visual and cultural connections with Waititiko -Meola Creek and Waiateao - Motions Creek
