We're upgrading the crossing and making bus stop location changes on Kalmia Street in Ellerslie

Kia ora,

We're upgrading the pedestrian crossing between number 28 Kalmia Street and 59 Main Highway to make it safer for local school children and easier for people walking to and from Ellerslie Station and the town centre. Upgrades include installing traffic signals at the crossing, widening the footpath, extending the kerbs on both sides, and removing the temporary bus stop so these improvements can be made. Work will take place from 30 April to 22 May and will happen at various times during this period. These improvements are part of the Road Safety programme at Auckland Transport. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we will notify you.

Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Between 28 Kalmia Street and 59 Main Highway, Ellerslie (see work location map on the overleaf).
When	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> From 30 April to 22 May at all times (24 hours).
What we're doing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Upgrading the pedestrian crossing with traffic lights to improve safety. Building out the pedestrian kerbs and widening the footpath. Removing the temporary bus stop outside number 21 Kalmia Street. Upgrading the existing bus stop outside number 19 Kalmia Street by removing an unused driveway. Upgrading the bus stop outside number 34 Kalmia Street and installing a seat bench.
How it may impact you	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Access to businesses may be impacted. Contractors will notify you in advance if your access is affected.
How travel is affected	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Traffic will be managed with a Stop/Go sign system, please follow all signs safely. <p>Traffic controllers will be on site to assist you around the work site. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.</p>

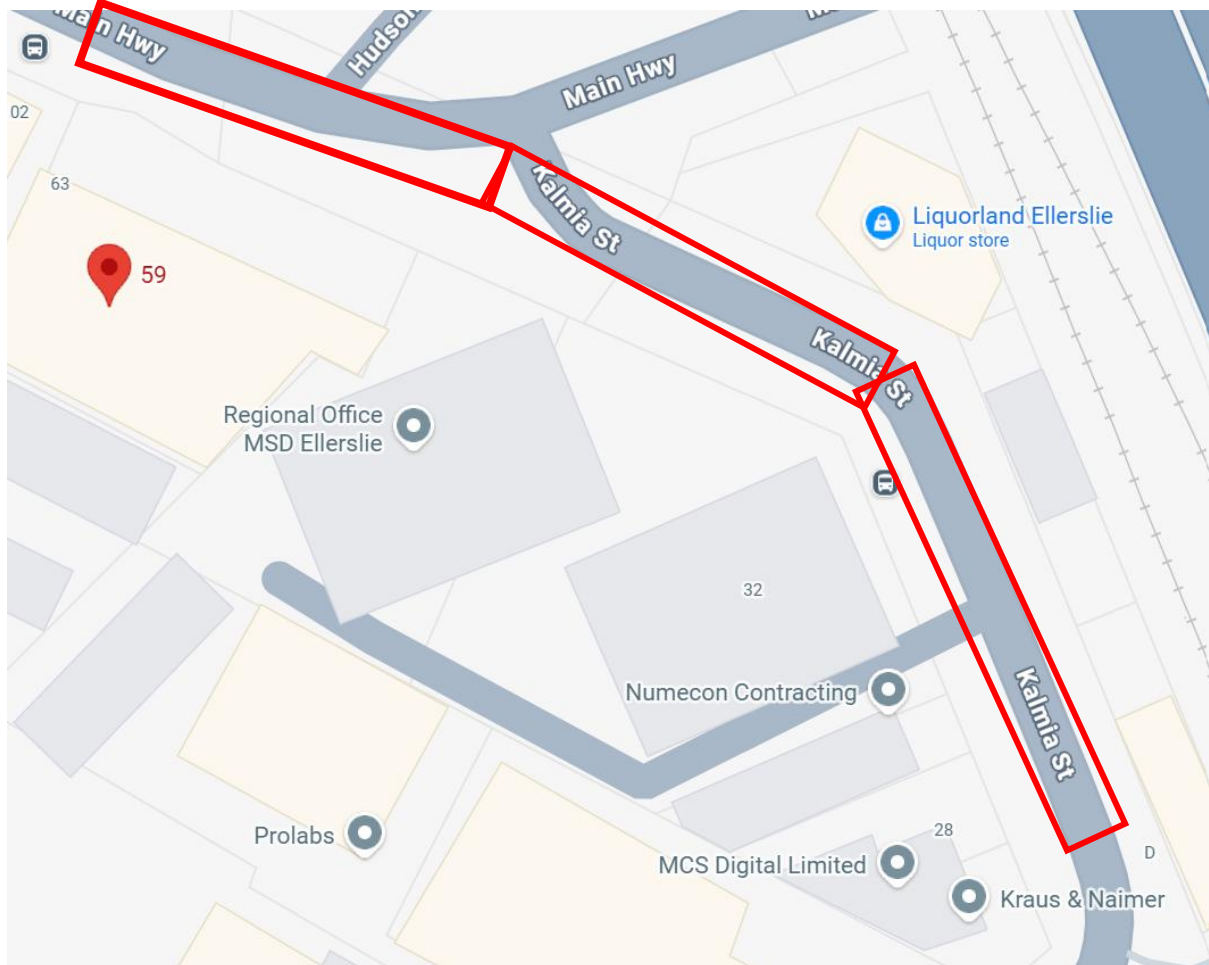
