### Aronga / Purpose

1. To provide an overview of the recommendations as endorsed by the Design and Delivery Committee (committee) at its meeting held on 12 November 2024.

### He Whakarapopoto o Ngā Whakatau ā te Komiti / Summary of Committee Recommendations

#### Room to Move in the City Centre – Draft for Consultation (Agenda item 20.2)

2. The committee discussed the proposal to publicly consult on the city centre parking strategy, Room to Move in the City Centre. The following key points were highlighted:
  - a) The strategy proposes a range of interventions in various locations within the city centre aimed at improving efficiencies in the transport system. It will also introduce more user-pays rules to reduce the burden on ratepayers.
  - b) Management was asked to provide details on how many car parks will be converted to metered parking.
  - c) 140 parking spaces (approximately 4% of Auckland street parking spaces) will be repurposed into specially designated zones.
  - d) A communications plan will accompany the consultation to mitigate the risk of negative media coverage and to ensure the public receives the correct messaging. This plan will include collaborating with business sector

advocates to promote how the plan will improve accessibility to the city centre and optimise movement of people and goods.

- e) Councillors have been briefed on the proposed changes and there has been extensive proactive engagement with stakeholders.
  - f) The plan aligns with other workstreams in the integrated city centre work programme led by Eke Panuku.
3. The committee endorsed the public consultation on the draft Room to Move in the City Centre plan for Board approval.
