


Additional rail buses to Newmarket

Customers paying by cash must purchase train tickets at a train station before boarding Rail Buses.

[•] AT HOP customers must tag-on when boarding and tag-off when leaving the bus.

Your AT HOP fare for combined bus and train trips will be calculated based on the start and end of the journey. The journey can use up to five bus or train trips within four hours, with a maximum transfer time of 30 minutes between each trip.
