Traffic Layout Change Monday 21 October 2024

From **Monday 21 October** there will be a new lay out on Great North Road for east bound traffic coming from Waterview and SH 16 and Pt Chevalier Road for southbound traffic. The current two traffic lane configuration nearing the intersection on both roads will be reduced to one lane for:

- straight through east bound traffic on Great North Road
- southbound traffic on Pt Chevalier Road

This change is so work can start on the library corner. It is expected that this new layout will be in place until mid-December. We suggest that you plan your journey if you need to come through this intersection or expect delays.



Unsafe / Illegal Parking

Several drivers are still parking on the grass berms, footpaths and cycle lane along Meola Road. This is very dangerous as they are driving over the cycle lane and footpath areas to gain access.

Footpaths are for pedestrians – not cars! Cycle lanes are for cyclists use – not cars!

For nearby parking, please use the MOTAT car park, accessible via Motions Road. To ensure the community can use the footpaths and cycle lanes safely our parking officers will be monitoring and enforcing illegal parking in the area.
