

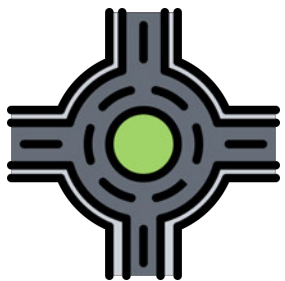
# Links to GI July Update

**Another month sees us well and truly into the second half of 2025. We're pleased to share our progress from what has been a key period of construction in Glen Innes.**

## In short



We've completed works on Line Road between the Merfield Street intersection and the West Tamaki Road intersection.



Roundabout works at Apirana Avenue/Pilkington Road/Tripoli Road are receiving final touches before full completion.



We plan to work outside 106 West Tamaki Road, before moving back down Line Road.

# Links to GI July Update

## Line Road

Our works on Line Road through July have been focused between the Merfield Street intersection and the West Tamaki Road intersection. We've been delivering concrete, drainage, kerb and channel works.

The next stage involves working at the most northern section of the project, near the shops at 106 West Tamaki Road.

Works include installation of speed tables, traffic islands and streetlighting, alongside pavement and kerb and channel works. We plan to complete these works by the end of August.

We will be upgrading the pedestrian refuge outside the shops at 106 West Tamaki Road to a raised crossing. We plan to complete this work by the end of August. Once complete, we will be making our way back down Line Road on the eastern side.

Finishing touches are also being completed at the Apirana/Pilkington/Tripoli roundabout in August, which will conclude the bulk of our project works in that area of Glen Innes altogether.
