Subject: Transport Reform – Change decisions confirmed

Dear AT supplier, please see below communication to you all from Phil Wilson, Chief Executive at Auckland Council, Stacey van der Putten, Interim Chief Executive, Auckland transport, following the change decision announcement to AT staff.

Kia ora,

We are writing to let you know that final decisions have now been made on the organisational structure to support Auckland's transport reform. This marks an important milestone in progressing changes to the way transport is planned, governed and delivered in Tāmaki Makaurau.

Transport reform strengthens and supports better integration of transport, land use and infrastructure planning across the Auckland Council group. The new structure supports these goals. We now begin implementing the transition to the new structure, and with this an assessment of all contracts.

Current contracts held by Auckland Council will not change. Auckland Transport contracts that fall under the functional and structural remit of the future public transport CCO will also remain unchanged, and stay with Auckland Transport, Auckland Council's Public Transport CCO.

For contracts where organisational ownership will change, we will contact suppliers directly to explain what is changing, when it will occur, and any actions required from your organisation.

The procurement teams at Auckland Council and Auckland Transport are working closely together to ensure suppliers are well supported throughout the transition.
