



Proposed new Vehicle Use and Parking Bylaw 2025 and its supporting proposals – Bylaw Panel Deliberations

Executive Summary

1. The Joint Auckland Transport (AT) and Auckland Council (AC) Bylaw Panel will deliberate on all public feedback, mana whenua and Local Board views received on the proposal to make a new joint AT and AC Vehicle Use and Parking Bylaw 2025 and its supporting proposals.
2. Each proposal, alongside the key changes sought from public feedback, will be deliberated on by the Bylaw Panel members, who will make recommendations on whether the proposals should be adopted as publicly notified, amended, or rejected.
3. Bylaw Panel recommendations will inform the AT Board and AC Governing Body's final decision in June 2025.
