The CBG

- Initiative from the Mayor
- Based on consensus building / engagement models – Land and Water Forum
- Broad membership
 - Chaired by Stewart Milne
 - AA, NZCID, CTU, EMA, Auckland Business Forum, AIAL, Campaign for Better Transport, Walk Auckland, Cycle Action Auckland, Child Poverty Action Council, Property Council, Tourism Industry Association, Tournament Parking, Landcare Research.

Purpose of the CBG

- To build a robust evidence-based consensus around the preferred tools to raise the additional revenue necessary to support the level of investment in transport projects required to implement the Auckland Plan.

Scope

- What is the best way to raise the funds necessary to implement the Auckland Plan.
- To engage broadly with the people of Auckland to build as robust a consensus as possible.

We are not:

- Reviewing or relitigating the Auckland Plan,
- Evaluating or reviewing the merits of individual transport projects
- Designing a specific ready to implement scheme.

Timeline

- Started meeting in October last year
- March 18 – background campaign started
- April 28 – Release of Engagement Document
- April 28 – May – Briefings and presentations to stakeholders
- June – consideration of Submissions
- July – report to Council
