## Glossary of words and terms

## <u>Meaning</u>

Berm ledge or shoulder along the edge of a road

Broken yellow line a dashed yellow line, used for no stopping parking restrictions

Bus box / Taxi rank box / loading zone box yellow painted box consisting of an 'L' painted perpendicular to the

kerb lin

Bus box the yellow lines delineating the extent of a bus stop

Catchpit a sump to catch water

Cesspit a sump to contain offal / sewerage

Centre line the continuous or dashed white line that separates opposing traffic

lanes

Channel / gutter the drainage structure associated with the kerb

Chicane a traffic calming obstacle placed within a road to slow traffic down

Continuity line a dashed white line that extends the edge line through an

intersection

Crosswalk

Cut through / walk through where a raised median / island has an at-grade gap to allow

pedestrians to pass through

Delineation line a dashed white line indicating the edge of the traffic lane through

an intersection

Edge line the continuous white line indicating the edge of the traffic lane

Extended line the extension of a line on the near side of the road, eg a kerbline

Hold line stopping position, at pedestrian crossings, intersections

Kerb extension where the kerb is formed out into the carriageway (without a water

channel)

Kerb stone or concrete vertical edging forming edge of carriageway

Lane line the dashed white line separating two lanes headed in the same

direction

Limit line the line across the traffic lane at a control, eg Stop, Give Way,

pedestrian crossing

North—bound approach travelling north and approaching a point, ie south side — preferred

use

Operation mobility box the head and tail of the restriction connected with a dashed yellow

line

Pedestrian kerb ramp (pram crossing) a kerb cutting especially for pedestrian use, typically at pedestrian

crossings

Pedestrian refuge island typically a pair of islands providing a respite area for pedestrians

crossing the road

Perpendicular kerbside markings:

Parking limit 'L' Parking limit 'T' parking limit line (baulk line) parking stall division line
