RE: Proposed cycle lane construction on Great South Road, from East Street to Sutton Road

Auckland Transport is seeking feedback on the proposed construction of a cycle lane on Great South Road, from East Street to Sutton Road.

This forms part of a proposal that will provide mainly on-road cycle lanes along Great South Road, from the Drury Interchange to Wellington Street, Papakura. The proposal does not include from Slippery Creek Bridge to Gatland Road as this is currently part of another scheme which includes cycling facilities. We also propose shared use paths on the corner of Great South Road and Rosehill Drive and from just north of Butlerworth Avenue to Clark Road.

Due to limited roadway width there are many areas where we propose to remove on-road parking. We do however propose to maintain existing recessed parking. Also, the survey results got back to us after the consultation drawings were completed. This survey indicated that we should implement some recessed parking in the vicinity of Drury School. We will be finalising these details in due course.

We propose that when adjacent to the kerb the cycle lane will be 1.5m wide. When adjacent to the parking the cycle lane will be 1.8m wide.

The proposed cycle lane improvement which provides access for cyclists is part of a larger initiative by Auckland Transport to upgrade the cycle network in the city. When completed, the cycle lane will link up with the existing cycle lanes on Gt South Road at both ends of the proposal.

Plans are attached outlining where we proposed the on street parking would be changed in the vicinity of your property prior to the results of the survey coming through.
