



# Tiverton-Wolverton Upgrade

## Site Activity

As residents, motorists and pedestrians, you will see there is now a lot happening throughout the construction zone. We are currently working in the following areas:

- New Windsor Road
- Tiverton Road
- Whitney Street
- Pinewood Street
- Pitcairn Place
- Blockhouse Bay Road
- Lansford Crescent
- Wolverton Street
- Miranda Street
- Saint Georges Road
- Amsterdam Place
- Olympic Park car park



Our aim is to install all services, including new watermains, telecommunication lines and power lines underground throughout the site by early 2013.

The service installation phase will sometimes require short-term disruption to driveways, roads, footpaths and bus stops. We would like to thank you all for your patience while we work as quickly as possible on this section of the work.

## Street Lights & Power Poles

We have now removed all of the power poles on the southern side of Wolverton Street from the Blockhouse Bay Road roundabout down to Miranda Street.

Three new streetlights have also been installed and livened in this area. This has been in preparation for the next phase of work involving the removal of footpath, kerb and channel.

## Watermain Installation

We hope to have three kilometres of new watermain pipes underground throughout the site by Christmas.

The areas where new watermains are being livened are:

- Northern side of Tiverton Road between Blockhouse Bay Road and New Windsor Road.
- Northern side of Wolverton Street between Saint Georges Road and Blockhouse Bay Road
- Southern side of Wolverton Street between Blockhouse Bay Road and Miranda Street.

For residents living in these areas, a process for installation will be in place to ensure a successful switch-over to the new water line.

### 1. Trial Shutdown - Ten minutes

Once the new watermain is underground we must test the new line. A trial shutdown is required and will temporarily cut the water supply for Ten minutes.

### 2. Shut-down notice

We then arrange an official shut-down time to switch the line over. Residents will receive a Water Care notice in their letterbox, providing three days advanced warning, stating when the water will be cut off.

### 3. Four hour shut down

Once the shutdown occurs, the water will be cut for up to four hours, and switched over to the new line.
