

NOTES

- 1. THERE ARE OTHER WAYS TO PROTECT FOOTPATHS DURING CONSTRUCTION APPROVAL TO USE THEM WILL REQUIRE COUNCIL APPROVAL.
- 2. UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL, PROVISION SHOULD BEMADE FOR CONTINUED USE OF FOOTPATH DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- 3. MINIMUM CONCRETE DEPTH OVER KERB AND BERM SHALL BE 150mm.
- 4. THIS PROTECTION SHALL COVER THE FULL WIDTH OF THE TEMPORARY ACCESS.
- 5. REFER CL. 3.10.3 OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE DESIGN STANDARDS MANUAL.
