## We're building a new cycleway and doing road maintenance on Merton Road, Glen Innes

Kia ora,

We are constructing an off-road cycleway and carrying out road maintenance along Merton Road, between the Merton Reserve and the Apirana Avenue roundabout.

Work will take place from 15 September for 12 weeks, overnight from 7:30 pm to 6:00 am throughout the week.

No work will take place between 6:00 am Saturday and 7:30 pm Sunday the following day.

Please note that wet weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay the start or completion of the works. If there are significant delays, we will keep you informed.


Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	Merton Road, between the Merton Reserve & Apirana Avenue roundabout (See location map below).
When	Work along Merton Road will be completed over approximately 12 weeks in total. We will be working in four stages to minimise the level of disruption.
	<ul> <li>Stage 1: Between the Apirana Avenue &amp; Morrin Road roundabouts (5 weeks).</li> <li>Stage 2: Morrin Road, near the Morrin Road roundabout</li> </ul>
	Stage 3: From the Merton Reserve to Morrin Road roundabout
	Stage 4: Felton Mathew Avenue, the near Morrin Road roundabout
	We will be in touch again with further details about stages 2 to 4.
What we're	Constructing a new off-road cycleway along the eastern side of Merton Road, and new
doing	pedestrian and cyclist crossings at the Morrin, Merton, and Felton Matthew Road roundabout.
	We will also deliver road maintenance and renewal works, including footpath, kerb and channel upgrades, followed by asphalt resurfacing.
How it may impact you	On-street parking will be limited during the works.
How travel is affected	Merton Road, between the Merton Reserve & Apirana Avenue roundabout will be closed during hours of work.
	Outside of work hours, normal traffic flow will be restored along Merton Road.
	Traffic controllers will be on site to help drivers and pedestrians around the work site.
	Access to businesses and shops would be maintained.
	Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.
