We need to do some work at night on Station Road

Kia ora.

We are in the final stages of our project to upgrade the roading infrastructure at State Highway 16 and Station Road to serve the growing community around Huapai Triangle Special Housing Area. It will make travelling through the area safer for drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists and better manage traffic flow.

With the project in its final stages, we will be applying line markings on Station Road. To achieve this, we will be working at night for three nights to reduce the impact on commuters. We ask that you allow extra time for travel and follow the detour signs posted as per the diagram below.

Where	Station Road
When	29 October – 31 October 2024
Hours of work	6pm – 5am

We'll do our best to start the work on time. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we'll notify you.

Take care if you're travelling through the area at night

Residents will still be able to access to their properties during the night works. However, access on Station Road will only be available to travellers from the SH16 end. The traffic management crew onsite will be there to assist residents and travellers. Take care if you'll be travelling through the area at night, and follow all signs, signals and directions by the crew.

We know our work can be a bit loud and that noise – particularly at night – can be disrupting. We try our best to avoid working at night, but sometimes it is necessary in order to avoid wider disruption to the community or to get the job done faster. When we have to work at night, we do our best to keep noise levels down.
