We're improving safety and accessibility for people walking, riding and using a bus between Point Chevalier town centre and the Westmere shops. The project is under construction and will be completed end of June 2025.

Amongst other benefits, the project will:

- Improved, safer pedestrian crossings
- Improve cycling safety
- Improved bus stops and new shelters
- Provide greener streets with more trees
- Create safer, slower streets
- Add seating and rubbish bins
- Provide a great environment for outdoor dining
- Improve stormwater drainage
- Rebuild Meola Road's foundations (completed)
- Move Meola Road powerlines underground
- Improve bus travel times
- Improve pedestrian access to Meola Reef Reserve
- Improve harbour water quality by separating stormwater and wastewater pipes
- Enhance visual and cultural connections with Waititiko - Meola Creek and Waiateao - Motions Creek
