Temporary traffic management at Sutherland Road will start from Monday 17th August 2026.

Kia ora,

The start date has now been confirmed for temporary traffic management at the intersection of Carrington Road and Sutherland Road, as outlined in our last work notification delivered on 7 August.

Investigations will start from Monday 17 August, with main works to follow. Once the investigations are complete, there may be a short delay before the main work begins while we review the findings. Please plan your journey for any minor delays to your journey.

Factors such as unforeseen site conditions or wet weather could mean a delay. If the delay is significant, we will notify you. Scan the QR code for more information about the project or subscribe to our newsletter for future updates and targeted construction communications.



Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	Intersection of Carrington Road and Sutherland Road
When	Investigations - From Monday 17th August and are expected to take 1-3 days Main works - From 24th August for approximately five weeks - Dayworks: Monday to Saturday, 7:30am to 6:00pm
What we're doing	Installing a new stormwater line and utilities
How it may impact you	No on-street parking: There will be no on-street parking on both sides of a short section of Sutherland Road; see map on overleaf. Vehicle access to property: Vehicle access to properties and businesses will be maintained. If this changes, Dempsey Wood will let you know in advance. Rubbish collections: Please put your rubbish bins out on your usual collection day. Our team will make sure collections continue during the works. Noise: The work may be noisy and may cause some vibration. We will monitor this and try to keep noise as low as possible.
How travel is affected	Stop-go during investigations: Temporary traffic lights will be in place during working hours only and removed at the end of each working day. Stop-during main works: Temporary traffic lights will remain in place 24/7, including outside working hours for approximately five weeks. Pedestrian access: Pedestrian footpath will always remain open; During working hours please wait for traffic controllers to safely guide you through the working area.
