We're upgrading essential services to support local growth, improve access and safety on Carrington Road in Mount Albert

Kia ora,

We will be starting work to upgrade essential services on Carrington Road, to improve accessibility and safety in Mount Albert. The upgrades will include services like stormwater, gas and watermain, pedestrian and cycling upgrades along with road widening. Works will start on 2 June 2026 and continue through until early-mid 2028 from Monday to Saturday, between 7:30am and 6pm.

Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, or your property is affected by works taking place outside of these standard hours, we will notify you. The Carrington Road Improvements Project is being delivered through the Traffic Initiated Projects portfolio. Scan the QR code to receive communications related to project construction that may directly affect your property, business, school, accessibility or regular traffic route.



Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Carrington Road, from Great North Road to New North Road including some side streets (see map on overleaf)
When	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2 June 2026 to early-mid 2028, between 7:30am and 6pm excluding Sunday (some work may need to be completed outside of these hours – we will notify you if your property is affected)
What we're doing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Significant upgrades to underground services – stormwater, gas, watermain and utilities. Power undergrounding on the western side of Carrington Road as part of road widening, to make the corridor safer and more accessible. Upgrading the Mount Albert rail overbridge to provide more space for walking and cycling.
How it may impact you	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> On-street parking will be limited during and outside of work hours. Vehicle access to properties will be maintained throughout. Works will create some noise and vibration; we'll do our best to keep noise levels down.
How travel is affected	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Expect delays to road travel during work hours and be sure to plan ahead, as lanes will be reduced at various points as works progress. Bus routes and stops will be impacted by traffic management at different stages throughout this period. More information will be communicated ahead of any changes to your bus journey. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist drivers and pedestrians around the work site. Please follow all signs and traffic directions.
