I would like to thank you and acknowledge the mahi and support of Auckland Transport in delivering the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023 (FIFA WWC) in Aotearoa New Zealand. The FIFA WWC was the largest women's sporting event in history. Almost two million people attended matches across both host counties, and well over one billion people watched on from around the world. Here in Aotearoa New Zealand, multiple records were broken as tens of thousands of people attended match after match, and more than two million Kiwis watched from home. As our biggest city with the largest portion of matches, Tāmaki Makaurau played an integral role in this success.

In particular, I would like to acknowledge the event-time efforts that went into supporting FIFA in real-time, including having senior personnel colocated in FIFA's MOC. The transportation integration, and agency collaboration contributed to the overall success of the tournament.
